Update on Night Work at the Expansion Site

Vancouver, BC (May 30, 2006) – The City of Vancouver has extended its noise exception permit for construction work that must be carried out in relation to low tide conditions at the Vancouver Convention Centre Expansion Project (VCCEP) site.

The extension covers the period from June 1, 2006 to August 31, 2006 from 8:00 P.M. until 7:30 A.M. the next morning.

The activities include excavation and shoreline treatments along the water side of the site, foundation work (mainly the placement of precast concrete sections, forms and rebar), some truck unloading and spotting, the installation of new marine habitat features and other related work.

Every effort is being made to help minimize noise levels as much as possible and work will not be carried out on Sundays or holidays.
